## **Class Description/Outline:**

Come join our advanced watercolor class! Using a limited palette of colors and other mixed medias we will learn wet on wet techniques, texture design and blending on paper to create a harmonious and fun watercolor painting. Finished painting will be approximately 11x14 inches.

## Supplies Needed:

Archers 11X15 Watercolor paper

Watercolor Palette (one that has individual for the paint and tray to mix paint, the bigger the better

Water bowl or bucket the bigger the better

Watercolor paints (Daniel Smith/Winsor Newton): alizarin crimson (or other red), new gamboge (or other yellow),cerulean blue (or other blue), sap green (or other green), yellow ochre, burnt umber (or sienna), raw umber (or sienna), lamp black, plus any other color you want for your painting. 1 inch painter's tape

Watercolor round brush (#6-12 is fine, NOT hog hair/bristle brush), square 1" brush

Pipet/eye dropper (optional) No.2 & 6B graphite pencil

Pencil sharpener

Eraser (white or kneaded is fine, NOT pink)

Micron 05 black pen (optional)

\*paper towels provided
