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# **Dashing Quilt**

### **Supply List:**

Please bring the following with you to class. Ben Franklin gives you a 10% discount on all supplies for a class.

- Dashing pattern by Lella Boutique
- 32 Fat Eighths..... Assorted prints.
  - NOTE: I used 6 reds (dark), 9 greens (medium), 10 greys (medium/light), 7 whites (light)
- 3 ¾ yards ..... Background fabric
  - NOTE: My background is Moda Bella Solids Charcoal 9900-284
- 3/4 yards ...... Binding fabric, (not needed at class)
- 4 ¾ yards ...... Backing fabric, (not needed at class)
- 81" x 81" ...... Batting, (not needed at class)
- Rotary Cutter
- Cutting mat. I highly recommend you bring a rotating mat, 12 x 12 or 13 x 13. It simplifies squaring a lot.
- Acrylic rulers
  - Bloc-Loc half square triangle ruler one of the following
    - 2.5 x 2.5 square
    - 3.5 x 3.5 square
  - 2.5 x 12.5 ruler (this can be slightly longer or wider...just close to this)
  - Optional: 4.5 x 4.5 square ruler
  - Optional: 8.5 x 8.5 square ruler
    - NOTE: I recommend Creative Grids rulers for the above two rulers. They simplify squaring.
- Fabric marking pen or pencil.
- Sewing Machine, thread, seam ripper, pencil, pins, pincushion, and any other sewing supplies you like to use. If you bring a small travel iron and pressing pad, it will simplify things for you. Ben Franklin also has irons and ironing boards available for you to use.

## **Cutting Directions – Please do this before coming to class.**

The following cutting directions are slightly different from the cutting directions on the pattern. The (4) 3" x 3" B squares will be replaced by a  $6 \frac{1}{4}$ " x  $6 \frac{1}{4}$ " square. This is what we will use to make the half square triangles.

NOTE: It will help if you bring your fabric already cut to class. However, if you are new to cutting tools, bring your fabric and I will show you how to cut it in class.

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From each of the 32 fat eighth prints cut the following:

- (2) A squares 4 ½" x 4 ½"
- (4) C squares 2 ½" x 2 ½"
- (1) 6 ¼" x 6 ¼" square for the HST (half square triangles)

From the background fabric cut the following:

- 8 strips 4 ½" by WOF (width of fabric). This is for the border.
- 8 strips 4 ½" by WOF
  - Subcut into 64 E squares 4 ½" x 4 ½"
- 6 strips 6 ¼" x WOF (for HST)
  - Subcut into (32) 6 1/4" x 6 1/4" squares
- 8 strips 2 ½" x WOF
  - Subcut into (128) 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares.

From the binding fabric cut the following:

- 8 strips 2 ½" by WOF

#### **COUPON:**

Stop by our customer service desk to pick up your coupon that will go towards your purchases for the class.
