French Roses Quilt

Supply List:

- French Roses Pattern
- Template Plastic (I prefer the heavy)
- Fabric Scissors- I used my standard scissors and 4" curved tip scissors (not necessary but really helpful.
- Marking pencil or pen.
- Thread coordinates with your fabric
- Standard quilting items -machine, rotary cutter, rulers(we have some in class)
- Fabric: The pattern calls for (5) 3/4 yard cuts of fabric for the flowers. In my sample I used (9) ½ yd cuts to get more variety. In my first quilt, I used a layer cake and added a (4) 1/3 yd cuts and a border fabric. If you would like to make your quilt scrappy I suggest aiming for a total of 4 yards of fabric for your flowers making sure they are at least 12" wide. You will also need 2 2/3yds of background fabric and 1/8 yard of fabric for your leaves.
- All of your fabric needs to be pre-washed, even if you are not a pre-washer!
- Batting- Twin Size- 72" x 90"
- Backing- We can discuss in class- at least 60" x 60"

I am a big believer in making quilts your own. If you want to modify your borders let me know I can walk you through yardage requirements for that.

COUPON:

Stop by our customer service desk to pick up your coupon that will go towards your purchases for the class.

CANCELATION POLICIES:
