Color Collage Tutorial- June

Block 6- Groundcover (4)



Step 1- Make 48 half square triangles.

Draw a diagonal line on the backside of the 2 3/8" powder squares. Pair with a groundcover square and sew on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the line and press towards the dark fabric.

Yes, I know it's a lot of squaring up, turn on some good music and enjoy the process



Step 2-

Make chunks. Press the seams to the left on the 2- half square chunk, and seams to the right on the floral square chunk.



Step 3-

Sew those chunks together to make 16 big chunks. Press towards the floral square fabric.



Step 4-

Draw a diagonal line on the backside of the 2" groundcover squares. Place on a Flora rectangle corner and sew on the line (or a tiny bit towards the corner) trim $\frac{1}{4}$ away from your sewn line towards the corner and press out. Repeat for the other corner.



Repeat for the powder/ blue laurel combination.

Step 5-

Sew your flying geese together.

Press your seams towards the powder/blue laurel combination



Step 6-

Make your rows with all of the chunks. Your top and bottom row seams should be pressed outward. The center row seams should be pressed inward.



Step 7-

Sew your rows together!



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
